Subject:-Grant of 3rd Renewal of Permission to All India Institute Of Ayurveda, North Goa, Dhargal, Pernem, Goa (Inst. ID AYU0806),with intake capacity of 100 seats (including EWS) in UG (BAMS) Course and 1st Renewal of Permission for 20 seats (including EWS) in 05 PG courses namely (i) Ayurveda Samhita& Siddhant-04 seats (including EWS) (ii) Kriya Sharir-04 seats (including EWS) (iii) Rachana Sharir-03 seats (including EWS) (iv) Agada Tantra-06 seats (including EWS) (v) Rasa Shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana-03 seats (including EWS)for the academic session 2025-26 under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26-reg.

Sir/Madam,

1. To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **All India Institute Of Ayurveda, North Goa, Dhargal, Pernem, Goa (Inst. ID AYU0806)** inspection was conducted on **24.03.2025 and 25.03.2025 in hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine NCISM to process the **3rd renewal of permission with 100 seats (including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 1st Renewal of permission for 20 seats (including EWS) in 05 PG courses** namely (i) **Ayurveda Samhita & Siddhant-04 seats (including EWS)** (ii) **Kriya Sharir-04 seats (including EWS)** (iii) **Rachana Sharir-03 seats (including EWS)** (iv) **Agada Tantra-06 seats (including EWS)** (v) **Rasa Shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana-03 seats (including EWS)** under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020for the academic session 2025-26.
2. The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the (NCISM) Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024", (NCISM) Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for Postgraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations thereunder.
3. Thereafter, the assessment report was placed in the **128th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM)** convened on **24.06.2025** and Board observed that the college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria for issuance of **3rd Renewal of Permission for intake capacity of 100 seats (including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course in accordance with Regulation 64(3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and 1stRenwal of Permission with 20 seats (including EWS) in 05 PG courses** namely (i) **Ayurveda Samhita& Siddhant-04 seats (including EWS)** (ii) **Kriya Sharir-04 seats (including EWS)** (iii) **Rachana Sharir-03 seats (including EWS)** (iv) **Agada Tantra-06 seats (including EWS)** (v) **Rasa Shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana-03 seats (including EWS)** in accordance with Regulation 45(3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and as per the Board's policy letter dated **09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025** under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020, for the academic session 2025-26.
4. Further, the Board decided to issue **3rd Renwal of Permission in UG (BAMS) Course with intake capacity of 100 seats (including EWS) and 1st Renwal of Permission for 20 seats (including EWS) in 05 PG Courses**, after clarification regarding the shortcomings observerd during the assessment. An opportunity of clarification vide letter even no. dated **27.06.2024** was issued to the college. In response of the same the college has submitted the clarification vide ref no. **11003/5/2025AIIA GOA/50** dated: **28.06.2025**. The submitted clarification was assessed and was found complying.
5. Hence, as per the decision of Board in the the **128th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM)** convened on **24.06.2025** after clarification the college is fulfilling the criteria as per the Board's policy letter dated **09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025** for

- a) 3rd renewal of permission with intake capacity of 100 seats (including EWS) in UG (BAMS) Course in accordance with Regulation 64(3) of (NCISM) Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024 under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.
- b) 1st Renwal of Permission with 20 seats (including EWS) in 05 PG courses namely (i) Ayurveda Samhita& Siddhant-04 seats (including EWS) (ii) Kriya Sharir-04 seats (including EWS) (iii) Rachana Sharir-03 seats (including EWS) (iv) Agada Tantra-06 seats (including EWS) (v) Rasa Shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana-03 seats (including EWS) in accordance with Regulation 45(3) of (NCISM) Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for postgraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.

"DECISION"

6. Therefore, All India Institute Of Ayurveda, North Goa, Dhargal, Pernem, Goa (Inst. ID AYU0806), is hereby granted with :-

- a) 3rd renewal of permission with intake capacity of 100 seats (including EWS) in UG (BAMS) Course in accordance with Regulation 64(3) of (NCISM) Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.
- b) 1st Renwal of Permission with 20 seats (including EWS) in 05 PG courses namely (i) Ayurveda Samhita& Siddhant-04 seats (including EWS) (ii) Kriya Sharir-04 seats (including EWS) (iii) Rachana Sharir-03 seats (including EWS) (iv) Agada Tantra-06 seats (including EWS) (v) Rasa Shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana-03 seats (including EWS) in accordance with Regulation 45(3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.

7. The aforementioned permission is issued under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-

- I. It is informed that minimum 50% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 100seats (including EWS) and 20 seats (including EWS) in 05 PG shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 50% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

8. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

9. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**

10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.

11. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college as per Regulation 64 of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and the compliance report shall be submitted before 30th November, 2025 to get considered for the issuance of Renewal of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**

- i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
- ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
- iii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for Postgraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
- iv) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.

12. In case if you are not satisfied with the decision of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM, you may prefer an appeal addressed to the Chairman NCISM, within 15 days of issuance of the letter as per Regulation 65 of MESAR 2024 and Regulation 29(5) of NCISM Act 2020.
13. The College administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the NCISM ACT and relevant regulation thereunder, are in position before the admission of 4th batch of students in the 1st professional BAMS and 2nd batch of students in 1st year PG are made under intimation to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM.
14. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for I, II and III professionals well in time in accordance with the Regulation (66) of MESAR 2024 which will be verified by the medical assessment and rating board and accordingly the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be considered.
15. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 35 of the NCISM Act, 2020 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
16. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the renewal of permission for the academic session 2026-27.
