Office Memorandum

Subject: Adoption and implementation of 'Integrity Pact' for procurement contact under Ministry of Ayush – Fixing of threshold value - reg.

Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) has recommended adoption and implementation of the concept of Integrity Pact (IP) by Govt. organizations, Public Sector Enterprises, Public Sector Banks, Insurance Companies, other Financial Institutions and Autonomous Bodies, etc. to ensure transparency, equity and competitiveness in public procurement.

2. In this regard, the Competent Authority in consultation with Central Vigilance Commission has appointed Shri M. Akhaya, IPS (Retd), as Independent External Monitor for Ministry of Ayush and its autonomous bodies, Statutory Bodies, PSUs etc. for a period of 03 years for adaptation and implementation of integrity pact (IP). The Independent External Monitor (IEM) would oversee the Integrity Pact implementation for the Ministry of Ayush and all organisations under the Ministry through structured meetings as per the Standard Operating procedure for adoption and implementation of Integrity Pact issued by CVC.

3. As per the Manual of procurement of work vide para 8.3 (ii) "Integrity Pact", the guidelines provide for the manner of determination of the threshold tender values as under:

"Ministries/Departments and their attached/subordinate offices (including autonomous bodies) should incorporate the Integrity Pact in the procurements/contracts of the nature and of a threshold value, decided by the Ministries/Departments with the approval of the Minister in charge. As guidance, the threshold should cover bulk (80-90%-eighty to ninety percent by value) of its annual procurement expenditure."

4. An introductory meeting had been held with Shri M. Akhaya, IPS (Retd), IEM in the Ministry on 13.2.2026, under the Chairmanship of DDG. During the meeting, the IEM also advised that the Ministry of Ayush would be required to determine the threshold values in terms of the above DoE guidelines. All tenders with value more than the said threshold value will be required to adopt "Integrity Pact" & details of such tender would also be requested to be reported to IEM in accordance with the above guidelines.


5. In accordance with the above guidelines, the threshold values for the Ministry of Ayush have been determined in the Ministry with the approval of Competent Authority as under:

S. No.	Nature of contract	Threshold value (Rs. In Lakhs)
1.	Procurement of Goods	11.00
3.	Procurement of Consultancy services (including consultancy for Works)	170.00
4.	Procurement of Non-Consultancy Services	120.00

5. All autonomous bodies, Statutory Bodies, PSUs etc. under Ministry of Ayush are requested to adopt "Integrity Pact" guidelines in all tenders with estimated value more than the threshold value by the Ministry, as in para 5 above.

It is also requested that relevant details of each such tender with accepted value more than the threshold value will be required to be reported to the Independent External Monitor (IEM) through the Ministry for quarterly review by the IEM.
